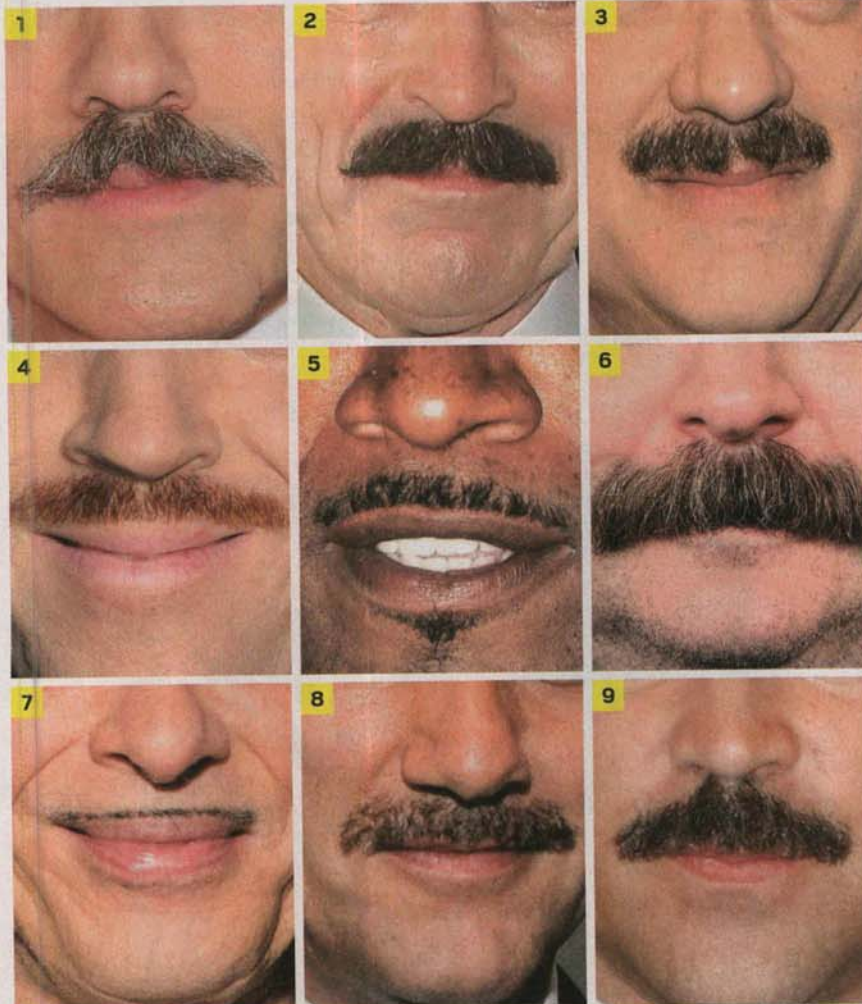


GIVING LIP
